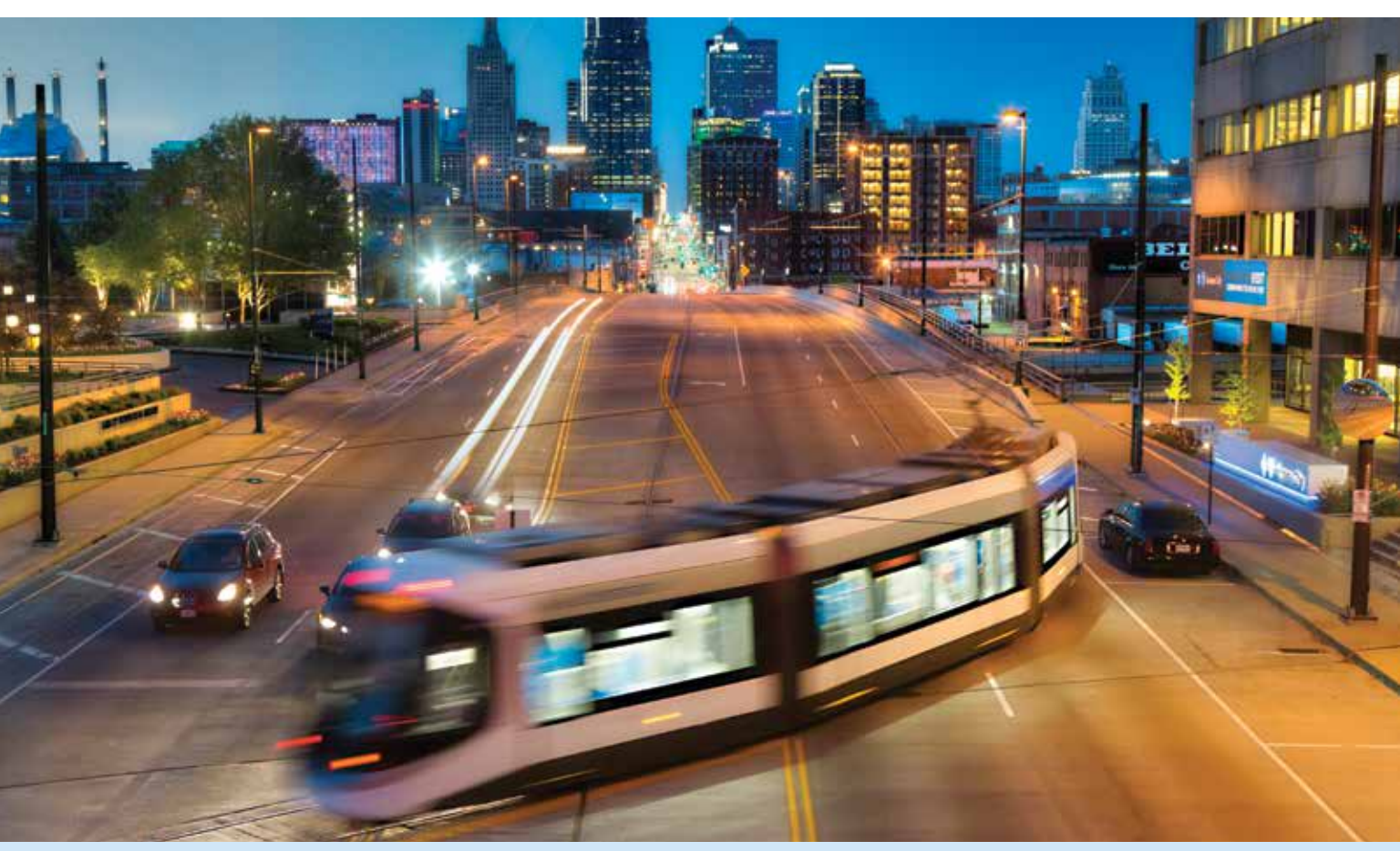

 The KC Streetcar is the newest way to get around Downtown Kansas City. Connecting you from the River Market to Union Station/Crown Center, the free KC Streetcar has 16 stops and runs 7 days a week. Got a stroller or wheelchair? Not a problem as there is level boarding available in the middle sections of the streetcar. The easy to understand route and 10-15 minute headways, makes the KC Streetcar the easiest way to get around Downtown.

18TH & VINE HISTORIC JAZZ DISTRICT
